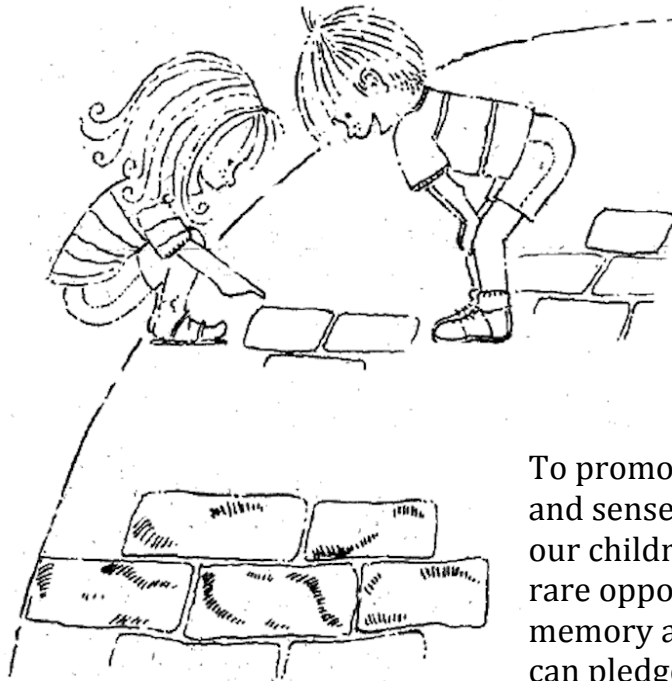
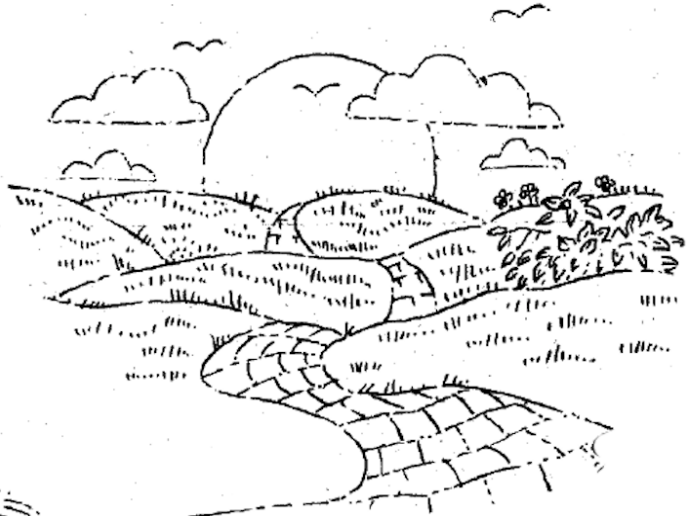


Chinmaya Sundaram Memory Brick Project for Bala Vihar Children
